Hello, and welcome to Lightwaves Leisure & Community Centre, located in the heart of Wakefield.

Car Parking and Travel

There are a limited number of spaces around the back of the centre, in upper and lower car parking areas. Please note, the lower area has narrow access, and is not suitable/accessible for large or wide vehicles. If you are parking with us, please sign in your vehicle at reception.

There are a number of Wakefield Council and private car parks in the surrounding area of the centre.

Close by, there is Wakefield Sports Club that has chargeable parking available, which is located on Eastmoor Road, Wakefield WF1 3RZ (Tel. 01924 365007). This is a private establishment, and not linked or affiliated with Lightwaves. The area is a ten minute walk away.

There is Trinity Walk shopping centre, which has a large chargeable car park (1,000 spaces). Postcode is WF1 1QQ. Further information is available here

Lightwaves centre is just over the road from Wakefield central bus station, and a 15 minute walk from Westgate and Kirkgate railway stations.

Centre Facilities

The centre is based over three floors. The ground floor is where the main sports hall is located. Next to the main entrance of the hall are changing rooms and toilets.

On the first floor you will find the main entrance leading into the main reception area. Here there are toilets, a water dispenser and an area providing drinks and snacks.

Local Amenities

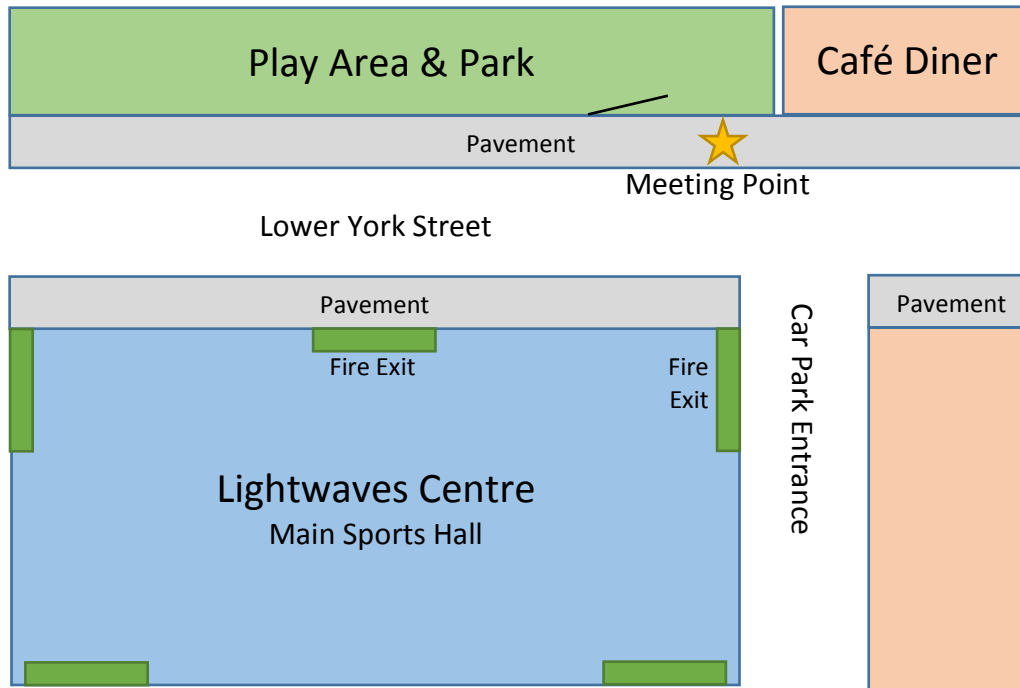
As the centre is based in the centre of Wakefield, there are lots of places to get food, drinks, and shopping etc.

There are two local shops just outside the main entrance. There is a Gregg's bakery in the bus station over the main road, and a Sainsbury's supermarket in the Trinity Walk shopping area, as well as many local independent coffee shops and eateries.
